About this journal

Journal of Social Statistics is an international journal dedicated to academic staff worldwide to publish their research work. It is a multidisciplinary, peer-reviewed, refereed, biannual journal organised and published by the Department of Social Statistics –University of Kelaniya, Sri Lanka. It aims to encourage multifaceted, multidisciplinary, and interdisciplinary research on South Asia, Southeast Asia, East Asia, Europe, and Africa to understand its fast-changing contexts related to global statistics issues in the World.

Manuscript Submission Guidelines

Please read the Author Guidelines and follow these instructions carefully. Manuscripts not adhering to the instructions will be returned for revision without review. The Editor in Chief reserves the right to return manuscripts that are not prepared by these guidelines

There are no fees payable to submit or publish in this journal.

As part of the submission process, you will be required to warrant that you are submitting your original work, that you have the rights in the work that you are submitting the work for first publication in the Journal that it is not being considered for publication elsewhere and has not already been published elsewhere. Furthermore, you have obtained and can supply all necessary permissions for the reproduction of any copyright works not owned by you.

1. General Guidelines

Authors' Affiliation: The primary affiliation for each author should be the institution where most of their work was done. If an author has moved to another institution, the current address may also be stated in the footer.

Co-Authors: The commonly accepted guideline for authorship is that one must have substantially contributed to the development of the paper and share accountability for the results. Researchers should decide who will be an author and in what order they will be listed depending upon their importance to the study. Other contributions should be cited in the manuscript's Acknowledgements.

Copyright Permissions: Authors should seek necessary permissions for quotations, artwork, boxes, or tables taken from other publications or other freely available sources on the Internet

before submission to JSS. Acknowledgement must be given to the source in the illustration legend, in a table footnote, or at the end of the quotation.

Abbreviations: Define alphabetically, other than abbreviations that can be used without definition. Words or phrases that are abbreviated in the introduction and following text should be written out in full the first time that they appear in the text, with each abbreviated form in

Parenthesis. Include the common name or scientific name, or both, of animal and plant materials.

Acknowledgements: Individuals and entities that have provided essential support such as research grants and fellowships and other sources of funding should be acknowledged. Contributions that do not involve researching (clerical assistance or personal acknowledgements) should not appear in acknowledgements.

2. Article types

Research papers: Must be 5,000-8000 words long but at most 8000 words, including tables, charts, diagrams, graphs and references.

Abstract: Provide an abstract of not more than 250 words and 4–6 keywords for articles.

Formatting: The preferred format for your manuscript is Word. Font size: 12, Times New Roman, 1.5 spaces.

Figures, Tables, artwork, and other graphics: Submit an original figure or photograph. Figures supplied in colour will appear in colour online, hence for the printed version, line drawings must be clear, with high black and white contrast. Each figure or photograph should be numbered consecutively with Roman numerals. Explanatory material should be given in the figures table legends and footnotes.

Page Numbering: Every manuscript page, including the title page, references, tables, etc. should be numbered.

Spelling: The journal uses American or British spellings, and authors may follow the latest edition of the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary for British spellings.

Reference style: The *Journal of Social Statistics* follows the APA reference style. View the APA guidelines to ensure your manuscript conforms to this reference style.

3. Plagiarism

Journal of Social Statistics takes issues of copyright infringement, plagiarism or other breaches of best practice in publication very seriously. We seek to protect the rights of our authors, and we always investigate claims of plagiarism or misuse of published articles. Equally, we seek to protect the reputation of the journal against malpractice.
