This provides detailed guidelines for using the citation and formatting conventions developed by the American Psychological Association, or APA. The major guidelines to format the paper in the following

<i>Section headings and subsection headings within the body of your paper use different types of formatting depending on the level of information you are presenting.</i>

The major components of an APA-style paper

1. Abstract
2. Body, which includes the following:
 - Headings and, if necessary, subheadings to organize the content
 - In-text citations of research sources
3. References page

All these components must be saved in one document, not as separate documents

References

Must follow APA (7th Edition) format. Only cited texts included.
