

Recognition of Outstanding Students for the Dean's List

Faculty of Social Sciences

Objective

To fulfill one of the requirements of students' performance appraisal, the university quality assurance unit of University of Kelaniya, has directed to establish a faculty wide award system themed 'Dean's List' to recognize the most outstanding student of the faculty. Therefore, in accordance with the UGC guideline numbered UGC/QAAC/STQA/01 on Faculty Awards and Dean's List, the quality assurance cell of the faculty of social sciences developed criteria to select eligible students.

The eligibility requirements are as follows:

1. Completed all the required credentials including compulsory courses and accumulated a minimum of 30 credits; and
2. Obtained grade of B+ or better for all course units registered in the academic year under consideration; and
3. Obtained a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.7 or above in the academic year under consideration.
4. Should have 70% or above class attendance

Any student who encountered the following incidents shall be regarded as ineligible to select for the Dean's list.

1. Any student who obtains an improved grade(s) by repeating a module(s)
2. Any student against whom disciplinary actions have been taken by the Vice -Chancellor or the Deputy Vice-Chancellor for any misconduct/exam offences shall not be eligible.
3. Students whose class attendance is less than 70% shall not be eligible.
